Tonight GET Council gave us the good news that they had heard our concerns. Many CRC supporters were in attendance, but for those who couldn't make it, here's the scoop!

Guelph Eramosa Township Council has voted unanimously to advise the Ontario Municipal Board that Council opposes the approval of the application for the "Hidden Quarry."

Mayor Chris White added: "Our residents have expressed a number of concerns related to the proposed quarry. While some were addressed in technical assessments, a number still remain unresolved in our opinion, or have not been resolved to our satisfaction. In light of this, we are requesting that the OMB not approve the application in its current state."

I have attached the full GET media release so that you have the full public version. The motion itself was very much longer, and the CRC Board will be delving into the details in order to understand the implications of the wording.

For now, let's cheer. The first round, in what will be a long, ongoing process, is behind us. GET Council is opposed. Without the very broad support and insistent questions from the community, GET might not have understood what a bad bargain the Hidden Quarry would have been for the Township.



In celebration of this accomplishment, I have attached a hot-off-the-press recording of the perfect theme song for CRC, "**Man-Made Thunder**", which was written for us by Rockwood's own **Wendi Hunter** of Music in the Wood.
