Knox Presbyterian Church was founded in February 1845 by Scottish settlers from Inverness, Aberdeen and Perthshire. Two years previously a Sunday School had been organized by Mr. John Burns at his home, and these workers composed the original congregation.

In 1847, the first church, a large frame building was completed. In 1850, Reverend John McLachlan was the first minister of the church. This church was in use until the new church opened in February 1895.

Today's church outreach includes the March Break Vacation Bible School in the mornings for children. There is also a play group at the Church on Thursday mornings twice a month. At the church you will also find "Take a Book, Leave a Book" collection.

The Church has hosted every January for the past nine years an Artist Benefit Concert to raise funds for awards for young artists from all disciplines from the area. This year's concert featured headliner Wes Mason as well as the Robert Little Glow Choir, Acton High School Jazz Band, the Acton DHS Drama Club, the Hazzards – Kevin, Jake & Walter, and many more!

The current Minister is Reverend Todd Nelson.
