Be it resolved that the Council of the Township of Guelph/Eramosa has received the delegation of Doug Tripp on behalf of the Concerned Residents Coalition regarding Requests for action on Frind and Hunter Hydrogeology Reports), and

That staff arrange for a peer review of the Frind and Hunter reports prepared for the CRC on the groundwater modelling hydrogeology for the Hidden Quarry official plan and zoning by-law amendment applications. Further, that this review allow for opportunities for dialogue between the municipal review team and the CRC's experts; and

That staff arrange for a peer review of the CRC's most recent submission on blasting impacts.
