CRC Receives \$1000 Grant from Wastewise

The Concerned Residents Coalition (CRC) is proud to announce that a grant of \$1,000 was presented to CRC by Georgetown's Wastewise on Wednesday, February 6 at an event celebrating initiatives promoting environmental sustainability.

In presenting the grant, Wastewise Board member Mike Foley stated: "Wastewise has been a supporter of CRC from the beginning and will continue to provide support until the environmental issues presented by the proposed Hidden Quarry are resolved."

Since 2013 Wastewise has made six annual grants to support the work of CRC as it assesses the potential impacts of the quarry on water quality and quantity, the natural environment, species at risk and fish habitat.

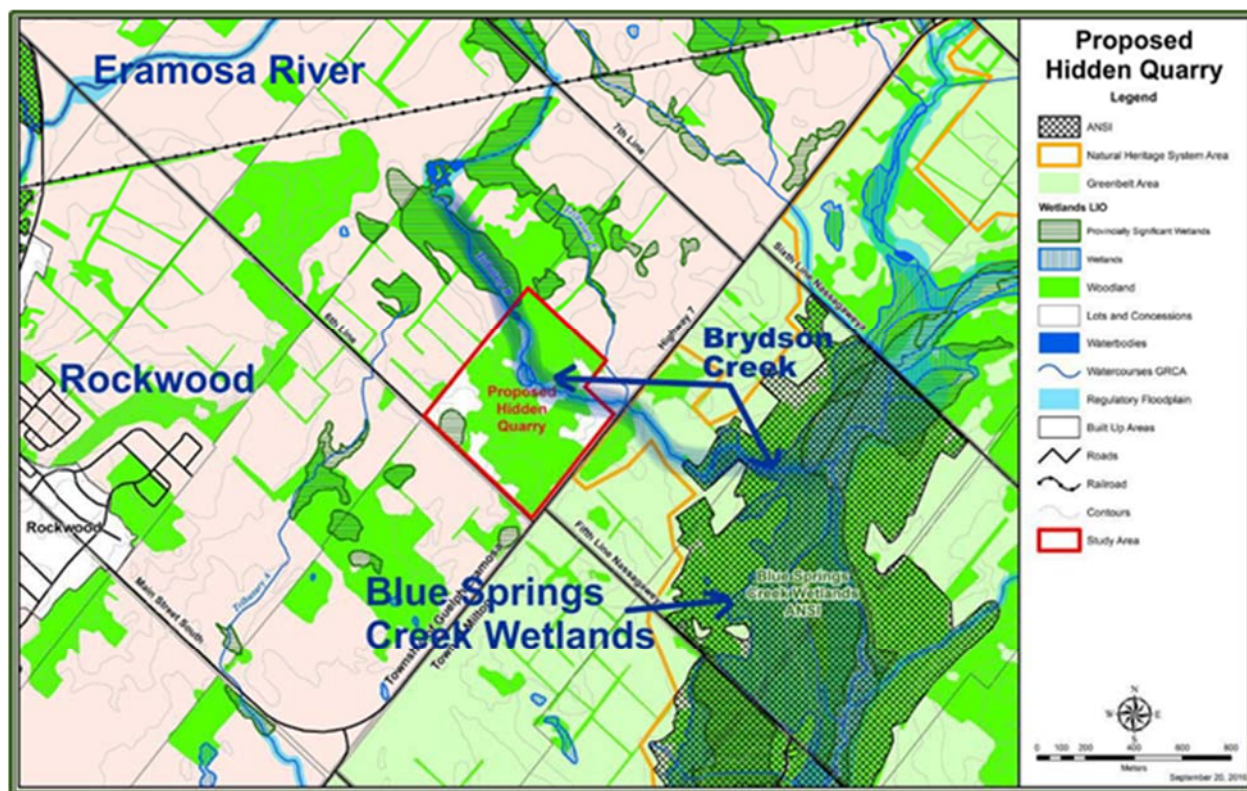
We may have begun with the aim of protecting an acreage in our neighbourhood, but our research has given our specific concerns wider importance as we address:
