**LPAT HEARING COUNTDOWN:
JUST 65 days to go!**

CRC never rests! Here's what's coming up in the next two weeks.

TOMORROW – Monday, March 18, 2019



Tomorrow, Monday March 18 at 11 pm, the CRC Strategy Group is holding a media event to bring the risks of flyrock to public attention and to demand that MNRF Minister Yakabuski set a minimum provincial flyrock exclusion zone of 500 metres.

CRC has created a flyrock danger zone along Highway 7. We've also installed a car damaged by flyrock on the south side of the highway across from the proposed Hidden Quarry site. If you are driving between Rockwood and Acton you can't miss it. The probability of a flyrock incident is low; but the consequences would be high. There are 19 homes and businesses **inside** the 'exclusion' zone defined by JDCL's blasting experts, to say nothing of Highway 7 and 6th Line Eramosa and 5th Line Nassagaweya. This exclusion zone does not meet international standards. And, believe it or not, there are no provincial standards. For more information, visit our Flyrock Page on the website!
