GET Council Announcement re Hidden Quarry

Monday, April 15 – 1:30 pm (NB: a. ernoon, NOT evening)

Guelph Eramosa Township Council will finally announce its position on the Hidden Quarry, and its role at the LPAT Hearing.

This week all Parties to the LPAT Hearing submitted expert witness statements and participant statements to the Tribunal. GET, the 'host' township for the quarry, has let that deadline pass before telling residents where it will stand at the Hearing.

It is interesting to note that there has also been no public announcement from Wellington County about their position, although we do know that they will be a Party at the Hearing.

Meanwhile Halton Hills and Halton Region have publicly stated their continued strong opposition to the Hidden Quarry and are acting on it. Halton Region will bring 7 expert witnesses to the Hearing. CRC will bring 8 expert witnesses.
